The proposed treatment would occur between April 22, 2019 and October 1, 2019.

If five or more individuals, organizations, special units of government, or local units of government file a request, the Lily Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District will conduct a public informational meeting on the proposed treatment. Interested parties can learn more about the proposed treatment from the permit applicant.
