C. Clerk's report - Clerk reported 1806 voted at November 8th Election. Included in the total were 417 people who voted by absentee ballot. 164 people registered to vote or changed an address that day. It was an 85% voter turnout. In 2012 (last presidential election), 1818 voted and 450 people voted by absentee. That year they could vote up until 5 p.m. on the Monday before election. Had that been the case, we would have had another 50 or so voters because people came in and called all day.
