

## **September 11, 2017 meeting of Wheatland Town Board**

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Glembocki at 6:00 P.M. on Monday September 11, 2017 at the Wheatland Town Hall. Meeting was started with the Pledge of Allegiance. Chairman Glembocki requested a moment of Silence for victims of 911.

Notices were posted in two public areas (Town Hall and Transfer Station) and the Town website. The Kenosha News and Westosha Report were notified. Individuals who have request meeting notices by e-mail were sent agendas as required by state law.

Minutes of the August 28th was approved by Andy Lois and second by Kelly Wilson.

**Fire Dept Report:** Fire Chief Lou Denko reported that they are moving forward with changes on the Summer Festival and looking for other options for fundraiser events. ( Will be a family orientated event) They will have a event, just not the Summer Festival. When they figure what their plans are they will let the board know. 2 Fire department members ( Lou Denko and Jeff Koenig)will be attending a Conference in North Carolina September 25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> 2017. Conference will be on about Fire Station, preplanning, and building and design, also includes combining multiple different department in one. Denko extended invite to board to attend. Chairman asked that Lou brings back info. Lou informed the board that the trip will be paid for by membership dues, and feels that they can come back with more objective opinions. Working with Building inspector Popanda regards to fire safety plans for two proposal made to the town.

**Public Safety: Constable Santelli,** informed the board that they need to consider purchasing squad car next year. Mileage is at 94,000 on car., Light bar shot, will need computer. Lou Denko has worked on the squad car; light equipment is corroded, really bad. Radio is ok. Kelly asked about speed reader for Lily Lake, Asked if he could get it for Lily Lake, Bob will ask Ray Roe to get it.

**High water drainage issues in Slades Corners:** Len Roecker sent proposal to town last week on engineer plan for, explain proposal for Drainage plans for Slades Corners. Relieve route that would be cost effective for pedal area for high water situation west of 396<sup>th</sup> along hwy 50, that area held a great amount of water, concern by the town and property owners, due to development or potentials development, is there a point that will jeopardize Slades Corners land owners. That the water will not get out of this natural kettle area. He has put together a map and 3 alternative. That will keep the water out of Slades Corners.

### **Scope of The Engineering Study should include the following items:**

Review the existing ground using County GIS mapping contour along each relief rout.

Evaluate challenges and obstacles along each route.

Prepare a preliminary plan and profile drawing for each.

Evaluate the hydraulic capacity and performance of each.

Identify property owners and agencies for each route.

Prepare a preliminary estimate of cost of each route.

Identify preliminary downstream impact of high water flows for each route.

Review existing documents of record in the area including:

STH 50 Construction plans and plats.

SEWPRC letter report # CA 112-32(dated June 26,1984).

Storm Water report & engineering plan for New Gen RV project (parcel ID 314-0640)

Town Wheatland records of high water events for this area.

Town meetings with Town of Wheatland, one meeting to discuss the study proposal and one meeting to present the completed study.

Bill asked Len if there was possible grant money or if DMV would pay for project or study as this may be caused by Hwy 50 4 land highway. Len reply it is a possibility as Hwy 50(four land Highway ) may have be part of the casuse.

Chairman Glemblocki wants to help out Slides Corners hopefully affordable and needs to talk to DMV act. Len suggested contacting local government Officials. Discussion on the three routes. Continued.  
License for Leah Beaudin was approved by Bill and Kelly.

**Road report:** Bill Said that Kenosha County will do 402<sup>nd</sup>, last and do Randall's road work first to save our road. Should be done the end of the month.
