September 17 – town will begin <u>mailing absentee ballots</u> to those voters who have a request on file.	October 14 – <u>online and mail</u> voter registration for the November 3 rd election ends.
October 20 – <u>in-person absentee voting begins</u> at the town hall Monday thru Friday, 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.	In-person voter registration up to and including election day continues at the town office any time. But please do this early if possible.
October 29, 5 p.m. – last day to request an absentee ballot <u>to be mailed to you.</u>	Other Election Information
October 30, 5 p.m. – <u>in-person absentee voting ends.</u>	<p style="text-align: center;">Registration INFORMATION</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Must be a Wheatland resident for a minimum of 28 days before November 3rd. 2. Must provide your WI driver license or WI DOT I.D. number when registering, if you have a valid and unexpired license or I.D. If you have never been issued one, provide the last four digits of your Social Security number. 3. Must bring proof of residence to register to vote if your driver license does not list your residence. Bank statements, utility bills, etc. constitute a valid proof of residence.
A brown drop box near the front door of the town hall on Geneva Rd. can be used to return your ballot. Follow instructions on the absentee ballot certification envelope for signing & witnessing and place the envelope in the drop box, bring it in the town office or return by USPO mail.	<p style="text-align: center;">Voting INFORMATION</p> <p style="text-align: center;">An acceptable photo I.D. is required to vote. Wisconsin issued driver license, Wisconsin DOT issued I.D. card, US Passport, US Uniformed Services card, etc. are examples.</p>
