

CHAPTER III.

TOWN CONSTABLES JURISDICTION AND DUTIES

SECTION 3.00. Statutory Authority. Pursuant to Sec. 60.22(4) and Sec. 60.35 of 1983 Wisconsin Act 532, the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Wheatland, Kenosha County, hereby establishes the jurisdiction and duties of the town constables of the Town of Wheatland, Kenosha County, as described herein.

SECTION 3.10. Jurisdiction and Duties of Constables. Any duly elected and acting town constable of the Town of Wheatland, Kenosha County, shall:

1. Cause to be enforced and prosecuted all violations of town ordinances of which he has knowledge or information.
2. Keep and preserve the peace within the Town, and shall have the full peace powers to arrest and apprehend any person, and for purposes of carrying out such duties, shall be considered a peace officer as defined in Sec. 989.22(22) of Wisconsin Statutes as revised and amended from time to time.
3. Direct and regulate traffic and make arrests for violation of Town traffic regulations adopting Chapters 194 and 341 to 349 of Wisconsin Statutes, and for purposes of carrying out such duties shall be considered a traffic officer as defined in Sec. 340.01(70) of Wisconsin Statutes.
4. Serve within his county any writ, process, order or notice, and execute any order, warrant or execution lawfully directed to or required to be executed by him, by the Municipal Court Judge, or by any court or officer.
5. Attend upon sessions of the Municipal Court of the Town of Wheatland when required by the Municipal Judge and the Circuit Court in his county when required by the sheriff.
6. Inform the Town Attorney and/or the District Attorney of all trespasses on public lands on which he has knowledge or information.
7. Impound cattle, horses, sheep, swine and other animals at large on the highways in violation of any duly published order or ordinance adopted by the Town Board.
8. Cause to be prosecuted all violations of law which he has knowledge or information.

9. Perform all other duties required by any law or ordinance.
10. Act on behalf of and/or at the direction of the Town Board as directed to.
 - (a) See that town orders and ordinances are obeyed.
 - (b) See that peace and order are maintained in the town.
 - (c) Obtain necessary assistance, if available, in case of emergency, except as provided under Chapter 166 of Wisconsin Statutes for emergency government.
11. Be authorized to issue a citation for violations of ordinances, including ordinances for which a statutory counterpart exists.

SECTION 3.20. Nonexclusivity of chapter and remedies.

3.21. Other Ordinances. Adoption of this chapter does not preclude the Town Board from adopting any other ordinance or providing for the enforcement of any other law or ordinance relating to the same or other matter.

3.22. Other remedies The jurisdiction and duties of the town constable as stated herein shall not preclude the Town Board or any other town officer from proceeding under any ordinance or law or by any other enforcement method to enforce any ordinance, regulation, or order.
