

CHAPTER X.

DRIVEWAYS AND CULVERTS

SECTION 10.00. Definitions. For the purpose of this, a driveway shall be defined as a private road, drive or roadway giving access from a public way, road or highway to abutting grounds.

SECTION 10.10. Application and Permit. No driveway shall be constructed or installed adjacent to or within the limits of a Town road right-of-way without first filing an application with the Town Clerk and receiving a permit therefor. Each application must receive the approval of the Town Clerk, or any other person appointed for that purpose by the Town Board, before the permit can be issued by him. The Town Clerk, or such other authorized person, shall approve the location and construction of the driveway and may direct and order grading, soil stabilization measures and/or the installation and construction of any culvert necessary for proper drainage as a condition to issuing said permit.

SECTION 10.20. Residential Driveway Limitation. No more than one driveway entrance to a public road shall be permitted for any residentially zoned parcel in the Town.

SECTION 10.30. Permit Fee. There shall be a fee paid to the Town Clerk at the time of making the application for a permit. Such fee shall be determined by resolution of the Town Board from time to time.
