

CHAPTER XXV

PARKING

SECTION 25.00 Official Parking Restrictions. Areas of parking prohibition and parking restriction shall be shown on the attached Appendix "A" which is incorporated by reference. Failure to observe the restrictions shown on Appendix "A" shall be a violation of this chapter and the Town Board may, from time to time, make additions or deletions to such Appendix "A".

SECTION 25.10 Violation of Parking Limit.

25.11 Forfeiture. Any person who shall have received a notice from a Town officer or constable that he has violated any of the provisions of this section may, within five (5) days of the time when such notice was given to such person or attached to his vehicle, pay to the Town Treasurer through the Town Clerk's office, a forfeiture of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars for the parking violation, as a penalty for and in full satisfaction of such violation.

25.12 Penalty. Any person who fails to make such payment or payments within the five (5) day interval shall be mailed a "Final Notice of Payment Due", which raises the penalty for late payment to a forfeiture of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars.

SECTION 25.20 Removal of Illegally Parked Vehicles. In the event a vehicle remains illegally parked in violation of Section 25.00, above, or in an emergency, or to facilitate snow removal, the Town Constable may have any vehicle parked in violation of Section 25.00 towed and stored. The cost of such removal and storage shall be charged to the owner of the vehicle and shall be in addition to any forfeiture imposed as a penalty.

SECTION 25.30 Sign Control. The Town designee shall cause to be erected or installed all regulatory signs and street markings necessary to give notice of the parking prohibitions and restrictions provided for by this chapter.

SECTION 25.40 Restrictions on Commercial Vehicles. No person shall park a commercial vehicle of greater than twelve thousand (12,000) pounds on the public streets, parks or other rights-of-way. This restriction shall not apply to temporary parking for deliveries and/or patronage.
