

CHAPTER V.

RECREATION BOARD

SECTION 5.00. Creation of Recreation Board. There is hereby created and established a "Town of Wheatland Recreation Board."

SECTION 5.10. Membership. The Town of Wheatland Recreation Board shall have members and be appointed as follows:

A. The Recreation Board shall consist of seven (7) members.

B. The Recreation Board members shall be residents of the Town.

C. Members of the Recreation Board shall be appointed by the Town Chairman subject to confirmation by the Town Board.

D. Members of the Recreation Board shall serve for staggered terms of three (3) years designated by the Town Chairman at the time of appointment and until their successors are duly appointed and confirmed. The terms shall commence on December 1 of the year of appointment.

SECTION 5.20. Duties and Functions of the Recreation Board. The Town of Wheatland Recreation Board shall advise the Town Board on matters involving park and recreation activity in the Town of Wheatland.

A. The Town Board shall refer to the Recreation Board, for its consideration and report, before final action is taken by the Town Board, all matters concerning park and recreation activities in the Town including park improvements.

B. The Recreation Board may make and consider plans for submittal to the Town Board concerning the physical improvement of park and recreation areas; however, the Recreation Board shall have no power and authority to employ experts or pay any expenses except as may be appropriated for use of the Recreation Board by the Town Board.

C. In general, the Recreation Board shall have the powers as may be necessary to properly advise the Town Board in order to perform its functions relative to parks and recreational activities in the Town, so as to best promote public health, safety, morals, order, convenience, prosperity, or the general welfare, as well as efficiency and economy.

SECTION 5.30. Officers. The Recreation Board shall elect a chairman and a secretary who shall serve for terms of one (1) year.

SECTION 5.40. Procedure. The Recreation Board may adopt rules for the transaction of business and shall keep a record of its resolutions, transactions, findings and determinations, which record shall be a public record.

SECTION 5.50. Per Diem. The Recreation Board members shall be paid a per diem amount determined by the Town Board from time to time in order to defray actual expenses incurred by the members of the Recreation Board in attendance at meetings and in the performance of their duties.
