

CHAPTER XXIX.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

SECTION 29.00. Possession of Alcoholic Beverages on Public Ways Prohibited. No person shall have in his possession on any public street, sidewalk or alley, or on or in any motor vehicle on a public street, sidewalk or alley, any open container of fermented malt beverages or intoxicating liquor.

SECTION 29.10. Restrictions on Sales to Underaged Persons and Intoxicated Persons; Presence of Underaged Persons in Places of Sale and Possession by Underaged Persons; Penalties. In order to prevent sales of alcoholic beverages to underaged persons, sales of alcoholic beverages to intoxicated persons, possession of alcoholic beverages and consumption thereof in public places by underaged persons, and misrepresentation of age, there is adopted and incorporated by reference all of the provisions of Section 125.07 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wisconsin as amended from time to time.

SECTION 29.20. Proof of Age -- Identification Cards. In order to prohibit the use of unauthorized identification cards, there is adopted and incorporated by reference all of the provisions of Section 125.08(3) of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wisconsin as amended from time to time.

SECTION 29.30. Penalty. Unless another penalty is expressly provided by the Statutes incorporated herein by reference, any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of an offense and upon conviction thereof, shall forfeit not less than \$50 nor more than \$500 and the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment shall be imprisoned in the County Jail for not more than 90 days; except that disposition in proceedings against a person who is under 18 years of age on the date of disposition shall be as provided by Section 48.34(4) of the Wisconsin Statutes.
