CHAPTER XXXIII.

CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES--REGULATIONS

SECTION 33.00. Controlled Substances—Possession Prohibited. No person shall knowingly possess, keep or maintain any narcotic drug, marijuana, stimulant, depressant, or hallucinogenic, or any other substances defined as a "controlled substance" in the Uniform Controlled Substances Act known as Chapter 161 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wisconsin, or any paraphernalia associated with the unlawful use of the same, unless the same was obained directly from or pursuant to a valid prescription or order of a physician or other licensed practitioner while acting in the course of his professional practice, or except as otherwise authorized under Chapter 161 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wisconsin.

SECTION 33.10. Penalty. Any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of an offense and upon conviction thereof, shall forfeit not less than \$50.00, nor more than \$500.00 and the costs of prosecution for each and every offense.
