

Special town meeting held at Town Hall Oct. 27, 1942, as was voted and decided. at last annual town meeting. April 7, 1942.

Meeting called to order by Peter Epling chairman, the clerk read reports of fire committee meetings, and gave a report of fire equipment Peter Pirsch and Sons Co. Kenosha would mount on a truck chassis at the cost of three thousand six hundred and ninety dollars (\$3690.00).

Clerk read contract of Peter Pirsch and Sons Co. Kenosha which was signed by the town board.

After a lengthy discussion a motion by Robert Pappis seconded by Henry Heidemann to vote by ballot, if town of Wheeland buy fire fighting equipment and truck chassis. motion carried.

Votes cast thirty one (31) thirty (30) in favor to buy fire equipment and truck chassis one (1) blank.

Carried.

Motion by Emanuel Storden seconded by Ben Kaskin the present fire committee in charge, have charge of the housing of fire equipment, in their care.

Motion carried.

Motion by Egon When seconded by Emanuel Storden the present fire committee in charge will send several voluntary fire departments for information how they operate their departments.

Motion carried.
