

SEPTEMBER 3, 2020 WHEATLAND TOWN BOARD MEETING

Meeting was called to order by Chairman William Glembocki 10:36 a.m. Thursday, September 3, 2020 at the Town Hall in New Munster and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Town Board members present: Supervisor Andrew Lois and Kelly Wilson. Others present: Clerk Sheila Siegler, Jill Rzeplinski and Tom Miller.

Notices were posted in three public areas (Town Hall, Transfer Station and Wheatland Center School) and the Town website. The Kenosha News and Westosha Report were notified. Individuals who have requested meeting notices by e-mail were sent agendas as required by state law.

Chairman verified with the clerk. Clerk stated he 24-hour meeting notice requirement was met.

Public Comments - none

Consideration and possible approval of removing the Slow No Wake Order for Lilly Lake

Chairman said board removed slow-no-wake order in 2019 on August 12 at a lake-level of 48.75" with the provision that if the lake-level went up, the SNW would be reinstated without a board action. SNW was again in effect by the September 23, 2019 town board meeting and has been in effect since that time.

Chairman measured a lake-level of 48" on September 1. It is nearly where it was when opened in 2019. He would like to open but have the motion read that the SNW can be reinstated if the lake-level readings fall below 47.5. (When he takes a reading, a higher number translates to a lower lake-level.)

Supervisor Wilson moved a motion to remove the slow-no-wake order but if the lake-level rises, the slow-no-wake order can be reinstated without holding a meeting. Supervisor Lois seconded. Motion carried. Chairman said the lake is now open until further notice at 10:30 a.m., Thursday, September 3, 2020.

Meeting adjourned at 10:40 a.m. on a motion from Glembocki, second by Wilson. Motion carried.
