

ORDINANCE NO. 2021- 003

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE SECTION 46.35
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF WHEATLAND
RELATING TO CONTRIBUTING TO TRUANCY

The Town Board of the Town of Wheatland, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, hereby creates Section 46.35 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Wheatland relating to contributing to truancy to read as follows:

SECTION 46.35 Contributing to Truancy.

(A) No person sixteen (16) years of age or older may, by any act or omission, knowingly encourage or contribute to the truancy of a child.

(B) A party is guilty of a violation of this section if an act or omission by the party either inside or outside of the Town encourages or contributes to a child being truant to the Town.


(C) An act or omission contributes to the truancy of a child, whether or not the child is adjudged to be in need of protection or services, if the natural and probable consequences of that act of omission would be to cause the child to be truant.

(D) Penalty. Any person who violates this section shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars nor more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars together with costs.
