

## **OCTOBER 18, 2021 WHEATLAND TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Meeting was called to order by Chairman William Glembocki at 4:00 p.m. Monday, October 18, 2021, at the Town Hall, and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Town Board members present: Supervisors Andrew Lois and Kelly Wilson. Others present: Clerk Sheila Siegler, Constable Robert Santelli and Wayne Kaddatz.

Notices were posted in three public areas (Town Hall, Transfer Station and Wheatland Center School) and the town's website. The Kenosha News and Westosha Report were notified. Individuals who have requested meeting notices by e-mail were sent agendas as required by state law.

### **Public comments -**

Wayne Kaddatz stated to the board that he intended to find a resolution for the stormwater flooding and high-water issues in Slades Corners in the next year. He will hire an engineering firm, water expert, attorney and whatever it takes to address this. It will be solved, and he is putting the board on notice.

Chairman closed public comments.

### **Work on 2022 town budget**

The board went over a proposed budget prepared by the clerk which reflects items previously discussed. Levy increase allowed under levy limits is \$6,889. This results in a total levy of \$715,996 versus \$709,107 in 2020. Rescue squad will be \$60,000, \$10,000 increase per approved contract. \$200,000 was added to the road paving budget. Recreation budget was reduced from \$63,275 to \$40,000 but the board agreed to add \$10,000 as requested by the Recreation Board to explore changing out the ballpark lights. Amount is now \$50,000.

Budget anticipated receipts are \$1,133,844; anticipated disbursements are \$1,446,237. Town reserves will be added in the amount of \$312,393 to balance the budget.

William Glembocki moved approval of the proposed 2022 Budget for presentation to electors at the budget hearing with a proposed total of \$1,446,237. Andrew Lois seconded. Motion carried.

William Glembocki moved a motion to set November 8, 7 p.m. for the budget hearing. Andrew Lois seconded. Motion carried.

William Glembocki moved to call a Special Town Meeting of Electors for November 8, 2021 immediately following the 7 p.m. budget hearing for the purpose of approving a 2021 town levy and street light district levies. Kelly Wilson seconded. Motion carried.

Andrew Lois moved to adjourn at 5 p.m. Kelly Wilson seconded. Motion carried.
